Attendance

We were visited this week by the EWO (Education Welfare Officer) from Central Bedfordshire Council. Attendance for the year should not fall below 96%. Those falling in this category will receive a letter showing their attendance data.

Homework

Can we please remind parents that, wherever possible, you read with your child every day. Also, don't forget to practice spellings and times tables for the weekly test.


