Information from Central Bedfordshire Council

Central Bedfordshire Council, Bedfordshire Luton and Milton Keynes Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG), East London Foundation Trust (ELFT), Cambridgeshire Community Services (CCS), SNAP Parent Carer Forum and Bedfordshire Police are working together on the Children and Young People's Plan for 2022-25.

The Central Bedfordshire Children and Young People's Plan 2018-21 explained how services would work together to support and help children and young people to enjoy life, have high aspirations and reach their goals. We are updating the Plan for 2022-25 and sent out a survey to get your thoughts. The previous plan was created and delivered before and during the pandemic. We know that the pandemic has disproportionately affected children and young people, so it will be important for us to ensure the Plan outlines the right services and support for them to be the best they can be.

Following the survey, we are now holding two co-production workshops to make sure our plan reflects the views of our community.
