ctivity umber	Activity	Completed
1	Using the sound fans, practise the Phase 2 and 3 Phonic sounds.	
2	Show your child a picture, this could be one	
	from a story book and ask them what they can	
	see. Encourage your child to write a sentence	
	about what they can see. E.g. 'I can see a dog and a duck'.	
3	Use your child's log in which is located on the	
	back of their reading record. To play Literacy	
	games on https://www.teachyourmonster.org/	
4	Read a story together on Giglets. Encourage	
	your child to find tricky words in the book as you	
	read. (She, he, me, we, be, was, are, all, they,	
	you, her, my).	
5	Write down the Phase 3 Phonic sounds on	
	pieces of paper. Call out a sound and ask your	
	child to jump onto the piece of paper with that	
	sound on. (If you would like a list of these	
	please feel free to ask).	
6	Play 'Phonics Pop'- children need to pop the	
	bubbles by clicking them with the correct sound	
	on. Choose from any of the sounds in the game	
	except the sounds with '_' in as we have not	
	covered these yet.

7	Write the letters in the alphabet.	
	Model each letter for your child and your child	
	can either write over the top of your letters to	
	practise or write them underneath.	
8	Ask your child to design a book cover for their	
	favourite book. What characters are in their	
	favourite book? What happens?	
9	Play some of the phonics games on the	
	Doorway First Phonics website:	
	https://www.doorwayonline.org.uk/activities/first phonics/.	
10	Practise writing some simple rhyming words.	
	Rhyming words are words that sound the same	
	such as hat, mat, sat, cat.
