# Children's Learning

The children have all worked really hard this week and it has been great to see all of their learning in class. In Diamonds this week the children enjoyed their first visit to the school nature reserve. They were all good at listening carefully to the adults and they all really enjoyed exploring the different plants, trees and wildlife. In their Math's lessons this week they have been learning all about different measures such as long and short, heavy and light and big and small. In Key Stage One the children have been continuing with their work on poetry in their English lessons. They have been learning all about rhyming words and were encouraged to write their own rhyming strings. They used their rhyming words later in the week to create rhyming sentences to add to their own poems. In their RE lesson they have been finding out all about what Christians believe God is like. This week they looked at the importance of forgiveness and what Christians do to show this in their everyday lives. In Key Stage Two the children have been learning more about the story of the BFG by Roald Dahl this week. They have used the story to plan and create their own newspaper reports containing subheadings. In their Science lessons they have been sorting animal skeletons into different groups and were able to discuss patterns and similarities and differences.
