Children's Learning

It has been wonderful to see all of the children's learning this week. In Diamonds Class the children have continued to try hard in their phonics lessons and they have learnt the new sounds e, u, r and h. They have also started to learn the key words 'to' and 'the'. In their Maths lessons this week they have been counting different amounts of objects and matching them to the correct number. They have also been learning how to write the numbers 1, 2 and 3 correctly. In their topic work they have learnt all about their bodies and how to take care of them by brushing their teeth and eating healthy food. In Key Stage One the children have continued with their work on non-chronological reports in their English lessons. They have been exploring the features of non-chronological reports and writing their own titles, captions and labels. In their DT lesson this week the children have designed their own fabric faces and have labelled the materials that they will use to decorate them with such as buttons, sequins, wool and thread. In Key Stage Two this week the children have been working on adding two four-digit numbers together. To be able to do this they have been recording their working out using the column method. In their English lessons the children have been continuing their work on the story of the BFG. They have been writing a letter to the queen in the story making sure that they use the correct features such as addresses, dates and speech marks. As part of their topic work they have continued to learn all about The Stone Age. They are looking forward to Stone Age Day next week.

Harvest Festival Thank you

Thank you very much to all of our parents and carers for attending our Harvest Festival at the village hall on Thursday afternoon. The children and staff have been very busy preparing all of the songs and poems for you over the last few weeks and we hope that you enjoyed it.
