Children's Learning

It has been lovely to see all of the wonderful things that the children have been learning about this week. In Diamonds Class the children have spent the week thinking about the topic of harvest. They created their own fruit and vegetable prints and learnt some harvest songs and poems. In their phonics lessons they have been learning the sounds g, o, c and k from the Twinkl phonics programme. They especially enjoyed their discovery tray tasks where they were finding different sounds and matching them to an object beginning with the sound. In Key Stage One the children have been learning all about non chronological reports in their English lessons. They have been organising texts into fiction, non-fiction and poetry. In their Science lessons they have been sorting animals into different types and have been writing non chronological reports about the bad giants in the BFG story by Roald Dahl. As part of this work the children had to organise and write paragraphs around a theme making sure that they used headings and subheadings. In their History lessons they have been continuing their work on the Stone Age. They have been comparing our life to life in Stone Age Britain by looking at the similarities and differences between the two times.

Black History Month

This week in our assemblies we have been celebrating Black History Month. While black history is celebrated year round, Black History Month is marked annually every October. It recognises and values the inspirational individuals and events that have shaped our world. During Black History Month, we remember and celebrate the important people from the past and also those who contribute to and help our society today. The teachers have planned some exciting lessons and activities to explore this area of the curriculum further mainly through stories and music.
