Just in case you weren't aware, we have a Teacher Training Day tomorrow so the school will be CLOSED.

Children's Learning

The children have had another wonderful week in school. In Diamonds Class this week the children have enjoyed listening to the story of 'The Leaf Thief' by Alice Hemming. This story was great for helping to explain to the children all about the different seasons in the year and what happens in each season. As part of their learning the children completed some speech bubble writing and created story maps. In their PSHE lesson this week the children were thinking about friendship and discussed how to be a kind and caring friend. In Key Stage One the children have worked hard this week on their new Mathematics topic on money. They have been learning to recognise coins and notes and have been using small amounts of coins to find the totals. In their Art lesson this week the children have learnt all about the artist Mark Rothko. They learnt to mix their own secondary colours on paper plates and chose their favourite colours to create blocks of colour in the style of Mark Rothko. They also learnt how to swish, wipe and blot their paintbrush. In Key Stage Two this week the children have completed their work on The BFG in English. They wrote their own endings for the story ensuring that they described the setting, characters and plot. In their Geography lesson this week the children have started to learn all about the key aspects of what is under the Earth's surface. They learnt important vocabulary to describe the different layers of the Earth and made models and drawings to show the cross section.
