Children's Learning

We have had an extremely busy time in school this week. All of the children have worked really hard to rehearse for our Christmas performances and the School Council have helped to decorate our Christmas tree. We have also been visited once again by our cheeky school Elf who surprises the children each day with his antics!

In Diamonds Class this week the children have been learning all about the numbers to ten in their Mathematics work. They have learnt to subitise, record numbers using tally marks and carefully count different amounts of objects. In their PSHE lesson this week the children were thinking about how to be a good friend. This links really well to our new whole school value of thoughtfulness and the children thought about the actions that constitute being a good friend and things that do not. In Key Stage One this week the children have been looking at spooky forest settings in their English lessons. They have used adjectives and expanded noun phrases to write a description of a spooky forest. They produced some super writing. In their Geography lesson this week the children continued their work on different types of weather. They discussed the hot and cold weather types in the UK and used a map and a globe to identify different hot and cold countries. In Key Stage Two this week the children have continued to study the story 'The Polar Express' in their English lessons. As part of their writing tasks they pretended that they were a character from the story who had arrived in the North Pole. They looked at the features of letters and ensured that they used description and wrote in paragraphs. In their Geography lesson this week the children found out more about earthquakes. They learnt about how the strength of an earthquake is measured, what causes earthquakes to happen and which countries are more likely to have earthquakes occur.

Parking Reminder

For the safety of the children and due to very limited space please could we remind all parents and carers that the front school car park/driveway is for the use of staff and visitors only and should not be used by parents/carers bringing or collecting their children from school. This is to ensure the safety of the children and parents/carers on the school grounds.
