Children's Learning

The children have had a super week this week and have learnt lots of new things. On Monday we started the week with a special assembly on our Value of friendship led by the School Council. They talked to the rest of the school about how to be a kind friend and the kind of things that a kind friend would do to help others.

In Diamonds Class the children have continued with their work on Traditional Tales and have been completing activities based on the Goldilocks and the Three Bears story. For their writing task this week they wrote some simple words and sentences to describe their favourite part in the story. They also used their Expressive Arts and Design session to build a new chair for baby bear using different materials. In their Mathematics lessons this week the children have been looking at the composition of the number seven and have been forming the number and making the number using different resources.

In Key Stage One this week the children have been learning to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division in their Mathematics lessons. They have learnt to calculate the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations, materials and arrays. Key Stage One have also been working extremely hard in their History lessons. This week the children learnt about Mary Seacole and how she travelled to The Crimea to care for injured soldiers. As part of this lesson the children also learnt about what kind of person she was and the prejudices she faced.

In Key Stage Two the children have been continuing with their English topic on the Charlotte's Web story by EB White. They have been writing descriptive words to describe Wilbur the pig and have been using and punctuating direct speech to show a conversation between two other characters in the story. The children in Key Stage Two also did brilliantly at their athletics festival on Thursday. Not only did the children try extremely hard in all of their races but they also represented our school very well and worked hard as a team to show our Values.
