It has been wonderful to see how well the children have settled back into school and they have already been working hard to show our new Value of friendship.

In Diamond Class this week the children have started their new topic all about Traditional Tales. The children will be retelling lots of traditional fairy tales and creating some wonderful pieces of artwork for the stories The Three Little Pigs, The Gingerbread Man and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. In their Mathematics lessons this week they have been recapping on the numbers to ten and twenty ensuring that the children can compare numbers and link different amounts of objects to the numeral.
