## Diamonds Nursery Literacy Homework - Spring Term

Activity Number	Activity	Completed
1	Write your name. This can be completed using pencil and paper or any other form of mark making (whiteboard, chalkboard, pens, paintbrushes and water outside on the floor).	
2	Sing the alphabet song.

6	Go on a letter hunt around the house, what letters can you see? Letters in books, on calendars.	
7	Make a collage picture of the first letter in your name. Draw the letter on a big piece of paper and your child can use any art resources you have at home to decorate.	
8	Ask your child to draw a picture of a story they have enjoyed. What happened in the story? Who was your favourite character?

10	Draw a picture of you and your family. Can you label who they are? 'Mum', 'Dad'.
