



This Term...

English

We have one final week where we will complete our learning on Charlotte's Web. We will be writing an advert to promote the Fair and a book review.

Then we will have half a term where we will be learning about Myths and Legends. Looking specifically at Pandora's Box and Medusa. We will be writing a letter of apology as well as describing the characters and finishing creating our own myth.

Mathematics

We will be continuing our learning of fractions. Looking at fractions of objects, shapes and numbers. We will also look at equivalent fractions and how to them. Then we will move on to decimals, 2d and 3d shapes and their properties. To finish the half term, we will look at finding the area of shapes.

Science

Our topic is States of Matter. We will be looking at solids, liquids and gases. How the particles differ in these. We will also be learning about the water cycle and how the process works. To finish the half term, we will be doing an evaporation investigation.

History or Geography

Our next geography topic is looking at the UK. We will look at what parts of the UK are like and where it is. We will be looking at the different countries and capital cities and the rivers. We will also look at how London has grown.

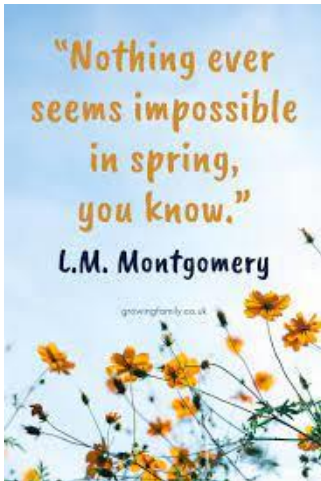
Computing

- Practice the non-negotiables, mentally doubling, halving, number bonds, telling the time.

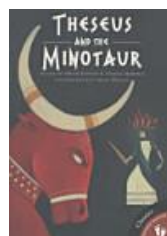
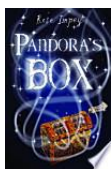
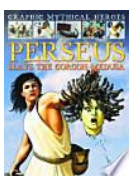
English
