Activity Number	Activity	Completed
1	Count how many objects in the fridge or fruit bowl to a total of 10/20.	
2	Sing favourite number rhymes i.e. 'Five current buns', 'Five little ducks' using fingers to show how many.	
3	Make all of the numbers to 20 using play dough, modelling clay or collage materials.	
4	Look around the home and find objects which are circles, squares, triangles or rectangles. Can your child correctly name each shape?	
5	Find a variety of everyday objects and put them into order of length. Which one is the longest/shortest?	
6	Look at the coins 1p to £1 and help your child to name them. Count out 1p coins to make totals to 10p.	
7	Paint or chalk all of the numbers to 20.	
8	Make a collection of objects which are the same colour. Count how many you have found.	
9	Find a variety of containers and fill them with different amounts of water. Which container is full/empty?	
10	Talk about days of the week and make a simple calendar to show which day it is.
